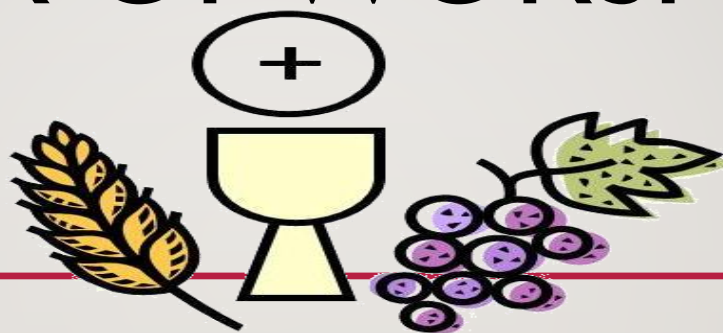

---

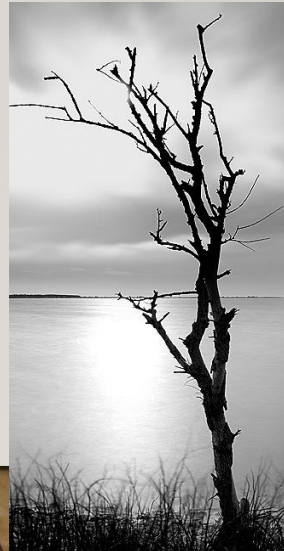

“This certain hope of being saved”<sup>Heb. 6:19 NIV</sup>



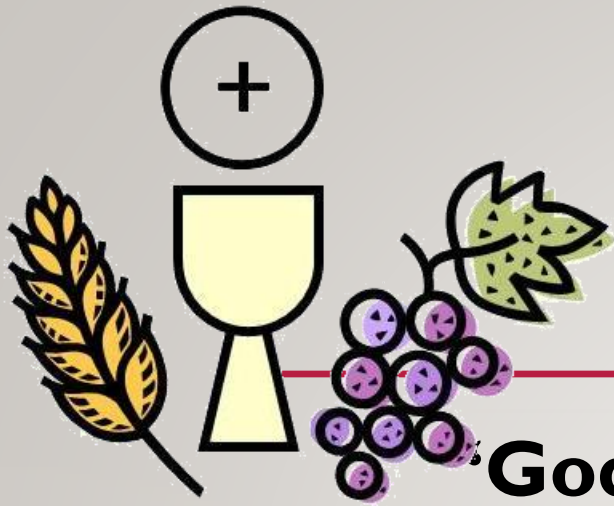
# HAVE


