DANIEL'S FIFTH TEST: Are You Learning From Those Who Came Before You?

SERMON TITLE: THE BANQUET OF OUR KING

Daniel 5:1, King Belshazzar gave a great banquet for a thousand of his nobles and drank wine with them. ² While Belshazzar was drinking his wine, he gave orders to bring in the gold and silver goblets that Nebuchadnezzar his father had taken from the temple in Jerusalem, so that the king and his nobles, his wives and his concubines might drink from them. ³ So they brought in the gold goblets that had been taken from the temple of God in Jerusalem, and the king and his nobles, his wives and his concubines drank from them.... hand that wrote the inscription.

²⁵ "This is the inscription that was written: MENE, MENE, TEKEL, PARSIN ²⁶ "Here is what these words mean:

Mene: God has numbered the days of your reign and brought it to an end.

27 Tekel: You have been weighed on the scales and found wanting.

Peres: Your kingdom is divided and given to the Medes and Persians."

THE POINT IS: AT THE COMMUNION TABLE BELIEVERS REMEMBER CHRIST, YOUR PROPHET, YOUR PRIEST, AND YOUR KING

1. REMEMBER: JESUS IS YOUR PROPHET

Exodus 4:22 Then say to Pharaoh, 'This is what the Lord says: Israel is my firstborn son,

Deuteronomy 18:15, The LORD your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your fellow Israelites. You must listen to him.

Matthew 17:5, While he was still speaking, a bright cloud covered them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased. Listen to him!

2. REMEMBER JESUS IS YOUR PRIEST

Lev. 16:32 The priest who is anointed and ordained to succeed his father as high priest is to make atonement. He is to put on the sacred linen garments ³³ and make atonement for the Most Holy Place, for the tent of meeting and the altar, and for the priests and all the members of the community. ³⁴ "This is to be a lasting ordinance for you: Atonement is to be made once a year for all the sins of the Israelites."

Hebrews 9: ²⁴ For Christ did not enter a sanctuary made with human hands that was only a copy of the true one; he entered heaven itself, now to appear for us in God's presence. ²⁵ Nor did he enter heaven to offer himself again and again, the way the high priest enters the Most Holy Place every year with blood that is not his own.

3. REMEMBER, JESUS IS YOUR KING

2 Samuel 8:15, David reigned over all Israel, doing what was just and right for all his people.

Matthew 22:41 While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them, ⁴² "What do you think about the Messiah? Whose son is he?" "The son of David," they replied. ⁴³ He said to them, "How is it then that David, speaking by the Spirit, calls him 'Lord'? For he says, ⁴⁴ "The Lord said to my Lord: "Sit at my right hand until I put your enemies under your feet." If then David calls him 'Lord,' how can he be his son?" ⁴⁶ No one could say a word in reply, and from that day on no one dared to ask him any more questions.

Romans 6:7-14, because anyone who has died has been set free from sin. ⁸ Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. ⁹ For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him. ¹⁰ The death he died, he died to sin once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God. ¹¹ In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus.

Revelation 1:5, and from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood.
