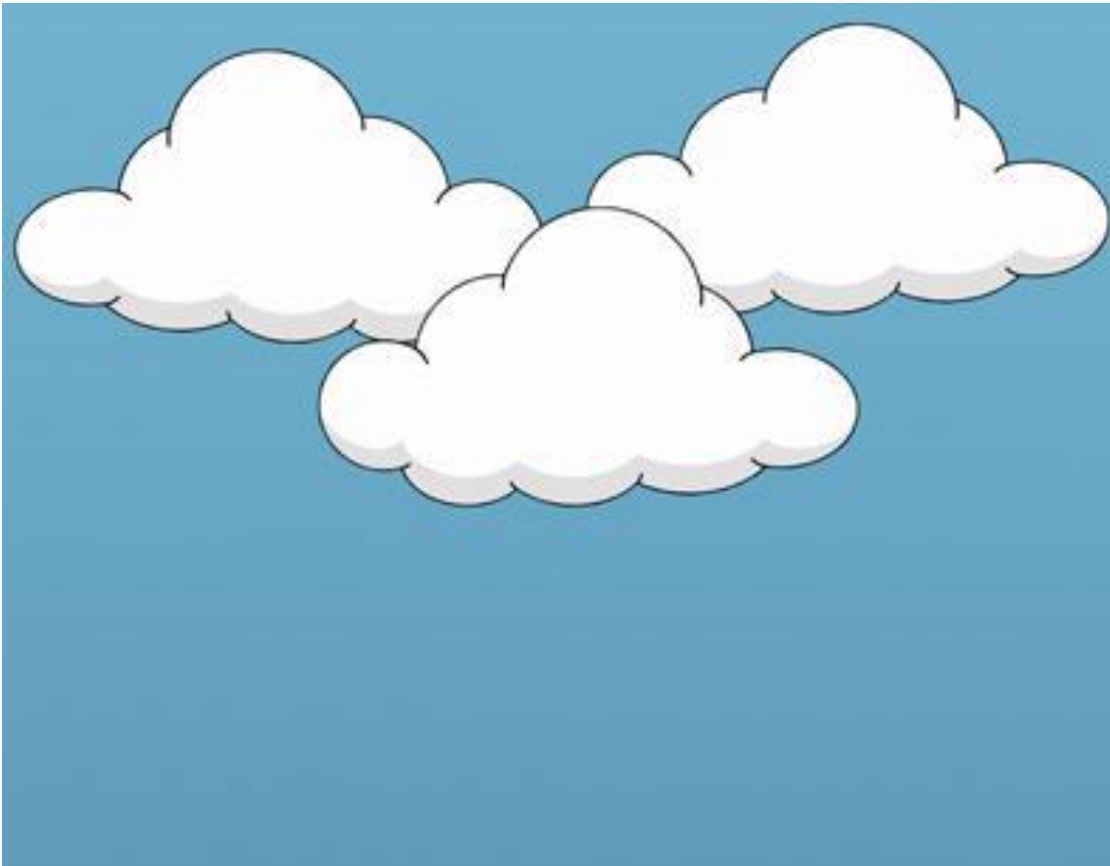

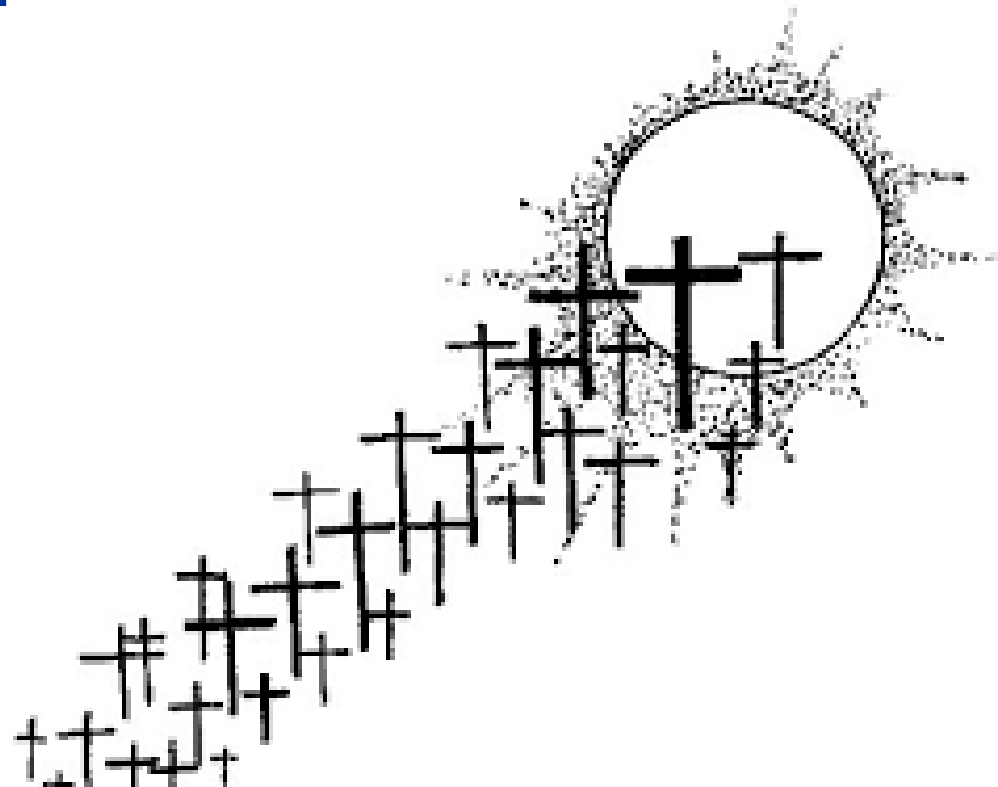

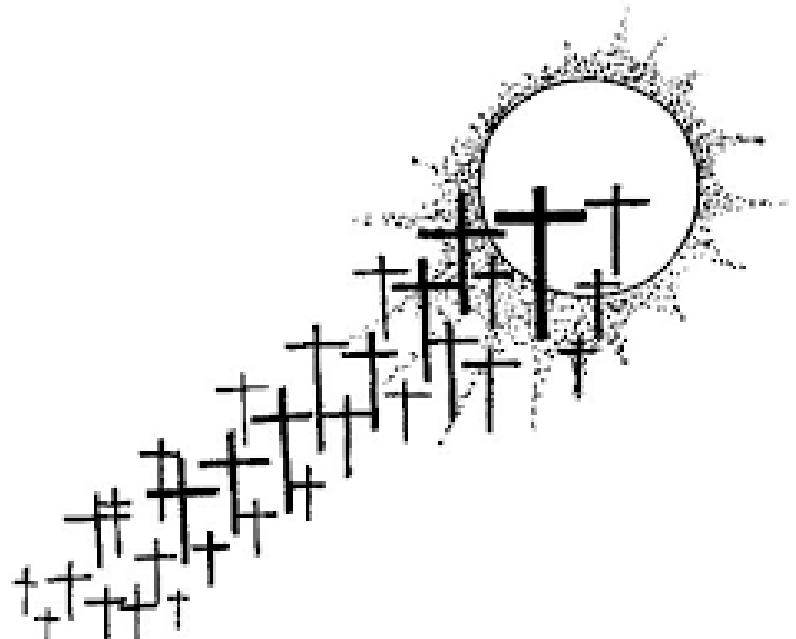
How Does This Make A Difference Now?

1. Remove your doubt about **Going To Heaven.**



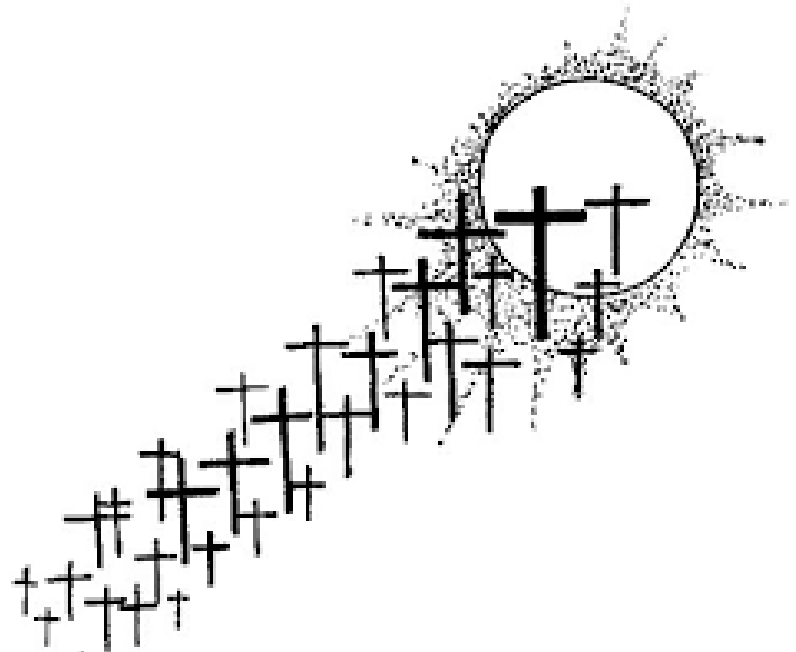
“This is what God told us: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. Whoever has the Son has life, but whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life.”

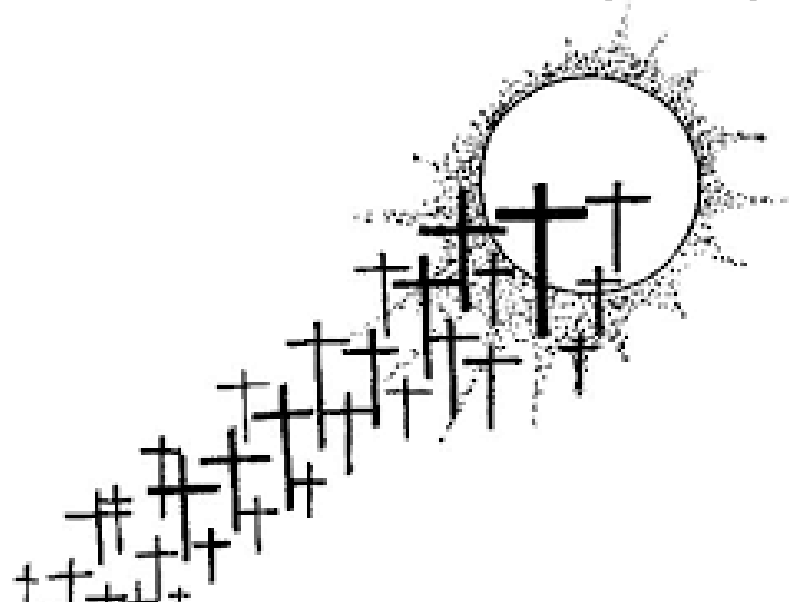
How Does This Make A Difference Now?


